Christ himself describes the second death, which is spiritual death, separation from God.

Romans 6: 23,....for the wages of sin is death....

Wages are something that we receive on a daily or regular basis, for work that is preformed. Therefore, unbelievers living in sin are affected by the penalties of sin daily. It is what they are earning. Not accepting salvation and continuing in sin until natural death, means being resurrected into our final payment for work preformed, which is the second death.

Luke 16: 22 – 23,....the rich man died and was buried, and being in torment in hell, he lifted up his eyes....

As the rich man was resurrected into the second death, he now sees and feels his fate. He realizes this death is final and permanent, eternal punishment. He is paralyzed with terror. The flame is tormenting, he is in distress.

Luke 16: 24,....send Lazarus that he may dip the tip od his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am tormented in this place....

Mankind will suffer mental anguish and despair, remembering the lost opportunities of his natural life. This is due to the constant reminding from the Lord himself.

Psalm 139: 8,....if I made my bed in hell, behold you are there....

Luke 16: 25,.... Abraham said....remember, that in your lifetime you received your good things....

The rich man represents all sinners, all workers of iniquity, that do not accept Gods saving grace.

Lets look into Gods word concerning eternity in hell, separated from God.

2 Thessalonians 1: 9,....these shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power....

Matthew 13: 42,....and will cast them into the furnace of fire, there will be wailing and gnashing of teeth....

Luke 16: 26,....and besides all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed....

The great gulf, will, through eternity, represent, all of those mental emotions, all of those thoughts of what if, all of those, I should have done this or that, but, none of this will matter at this point.

Mark 8: 36,....for what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul....

Matthew 25: 41,....depart from me, you cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels....

Revelation 14: 11,....and the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever, and they have no rest day or night....

Revelation 20: 15,....and anyone not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire....

Revelation 21: 8,....but the cowardly, unbelieving....shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death....

There are many scriptures throughout the word of God, that depicts the eternal damnation that is reserved for those who do not accept Gods saving grace.

More importantly, and what we should focus on in our Christian life, is the mystery of the word, the doctrine of our salvation, given unto all, through Christ and the cross.
