Our Eternal Security - Bible Study

Make your own notes, write down other scriptures that you have run across while studying, write down questions that you may have or comments as well. Allow the Holy Spirit to reveal to you what he would have you to see through the bible study.

Those who come to Christ will be accepted and will see eternal life. They will not be rejected, they will not fail to maintain this salvation, to the end.

John 6: 35 — 40,.... And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst. But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not. All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out. For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me. And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

John 6:35 - 40,....strongly affirms the eternal security of the believer and shows the believer's eternal security.

What then is the will of the Father?

John 6:38 - 39,....Jesus then repeated His claim about His heavenly origin. The reason He came down from heaven was to do the will of the Father who sent Him. The Father's will is that those whom He gives to the Son will not suffer a single loss and all will be raised to life in the resurrection.

John 6:39,....This is the will of Him who sent Me, that all that He has given Me I lose nothing, but raise it up on the last day.

John 6:40,....For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes on Him may have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day.

This verse repeats and reinforces the ideas of the previous verses. One who looks and believes on Jesus for salvation has his destiny secure. The divine decree has insured that He has eternal life and will be raised at the last day.

The believer's eternal security is seen by the fact that the Father's will is that those whom He has given to Jesus will not be lost, but raised up on the last day. That everyone who believes on Jesus will have eternal life and that Jesus will raise him up on the last day.

Having once come to the Father through Christ, once having believed on Christ, the believer is eternally secure because it is the Father's will that Jesus not lose him. And Jesus will do the will of the Father and not lose any whom the Father gave to Him, and will raise them up on the last day.

If you believe that Jesus will do the will of the Father and not lose any who have believed on Him, then why would we doubt the believer's eternal security.

There are those who do not believe in the eternal security of the believer, they say that the believer's eternal salvation can be lost, but what can be more clear and direct than the Father's will that Jesus lose none of those who have believed on Him?

Some will insist that you must work for your salvation, or add works to your faith for salvation.

They will say that if you sin you can lose your salvation, but that ignores the fact that believer's do sin, and yet it is God's will that Jesus lose none whom the Father has given Him.

They will say that if you lose your faith you will lose your salvation. But again, that ignores the fact that Jesus will do the will of the Father and not lose any whom the Father has given to Him.

The believer is commanded to pick up his cross and follow Jesus.

Matthew 16:24,....Then Jesus said to His disciples, If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow me.

Once you have believed on Christ, Jesus will not lose you, but will obey the Father's will. The believer has eternal life right now, at the present moment, and cannot lose it. Eternal life is a free gift and the calling of God and His gifts are irrevocable. God will not revoke the free gift of eternal life He has given to those who believe on Christ.

Romans 5:15,....But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one that many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to many. The gift is not like that which came through the one who sinned; for on the one hand the judgment arose from one transgression resulting in condemnation, but on the other hand the free gift arose from many transgressions resulting in justification.

Romans 11:29,....for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

Romans 8:30,....and these whom He predestined, He also called, and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.

John 10: 27 – 30,.... My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any [man] pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave [them] me, is greater than all; and no [man] is able to pluck [them] out of my Father's hand. I and [my] Father are one.

1 John 5: 13,.... These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.....

John 5: 24,....Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

John 3: 16,....For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

People In hell have never known Christ, Jesus did not say, I once knew you, but you lost your salvation. People who trust in their own works are not saved. Salvation is by grace not by our works. None are worthy of salvation, salvation is God's gift (We Deserve Death). Salvation Is eternal, and everlasting which means never ending.

Whosoever believeth on the Father has passed from death unto life. Today is the day of salvation, and if you will accept I will not blot out your name out of the book of life. "God will never leave thee nor forsake thee"

Those whom God has given to Christ will undoubtedly see eternal life. Christ said that those who have come to him in faith believing, as given to him, by God the Father, are guaranteed not to be lost, and are assured of being raised up in the last day.
