Jesus, The Light of the World

John 8: 12 – 27

As Christians, the word of God teaches us that, expressing the true gospel of Salvation to the world will cause hostility between the life of the believer and that of the world. Mankind will also have determination to discredit our testimony by whatever means necessary. Just as Christ was in his final year of ministry in this week's lesson, which meant the intensity of this determination against him was increasing, so it is in the life of the believer today as we live in the last days of this church age, before the bride of Christ is raptured out of this world. Satan is trying to discredit the truth of salvation by whatever means possible, in order for his lies of deception to come forth in the manner of many false prophets. Christ bore witness of his own sinless life by, claiming his deity in God the Father. Christ will bare witness through our life today by, giving us the gift of his salvation and, the power of his salvation through the gift of the Holy Spirit, this is to show his salvation unto the world.

John 8: 32,....and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free....

There are many who, truly believe in Christ as their savior, there are many who, have trusted in him as their redeemer, and there are many who, have placed their faith in him for salvation, but, not all choose to abide in that truth of his word, and for this reason they can become prey to false gospels, false religions, and false teachings that will distort the truth of Gods word. We must abide in prayer, we must abide in the word of God, so that we may learn of Christ, and grow in his grace. Obedience to Gods word means, spiritual growth, spiritual growth means, spiritual maturity. The more that we mature spiritually in Christ, the more that we will develop in our freedom from sinfulness, which keeps us from worldly bondage, and allows us to live our life, in spirit and in truth.

John 8: 12 - 14,....Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world....

Christ, who came to the earth, to allow his light to shine in darkness, to enlighten the darkened soul of man, to free mankind from this spiritual darkness, using the enlightened eternal love of God. His light is pure light, a redeeming light, which brings new life into all who is dead in trespasses and sins, who will accept this light freely.

John 1: 5,.... and the light shineth in darkness, and the darkness comprehended it not....

As a world that continues in darkness, God has given humanity the ability to look to his goodness and grace through his Son. Christ, who left his glory above, clothed himself in human flesh, allowed himself to be born into a fallen race, so that the saving grace of his light, his truth, and his love could shine forth, to put a spark of hope into the soul of man. Therefore, man has been given free will to accept this glorious light of the gospel of grace and to be placed into the brightness of Gods eternal kingdom.

Acts 4: 12 - 14,....neither is there salvation in any other, for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved....

John 8: 15 - 18,....ye judge after the flesh, I judge no man....

**John 3: 17,....** for God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through him might be saved....

Humanity lives under condemnation of God, due to sin and the choice to continue to live in sin, sadly so do many believers. This is due to unbelief in the word of God, and disobedience to the word of God. If, as believers, we would be obedient to the word, we would not judge, nor would we be judged, but we would live and rejoice in the Lord.

We must live our lives unto the Lord, and not unto the gratification of man. In this, mankind finds it easy to pass judgement according to his own emotional opinions and interpretations of the scriptures. None can know the mind of another except for Christ, none can assess the motives of another except for Christ. There are areas in which the Christian has been given the right and the authority to make corrections, but this authority is to be used against the destructive forces of evil, so that all may hold onto that which is good and pleasing in the sight of God. Unrighteous judgement brings about the destruction of our spiritual peace and joy. God gives wisdom and discernment through the indwelling Holy Spirit, to judge between that which is good and that which is evil, according to the given word of God. We must study the word with an understanding heart so, that with Godly discernment we may see the correct spiritual context and apply it to our lives in spirit and in truth.

John 8: 19 - 20,....ye neither knew me, nor my Father, if you had known me, you should have known my Father also....

Christ who is the perfect pattern of human life, the greatest example to humanity of how that God would have us to live our lives in spirit and in truth and submitted fully unto the desired will of God. Man was created to represent God upon this earth and, man was appointed to rule over all that God had created upon this earth and to come under his sovereign authority. Because of sin, deception and transgression, man fell from Gods grace, and therefore became incapable of living within the desires of Gods proposed plan.

For this reason, when God sent his only begotten Son, the arrogancy of man refused to acknowledge the truth of a savior who was sent in the image of an invisible God, the exact representative of Gods very being. He came to show man how to live, and to give his life as a ransom price for all who would believe. Man would not listen, and questioned every truth that God had to share.

Colossians 1: 12 - 20,....who is the image of the invisible God, the first born of every creature....

Those who acknowledge the Son, also acknowledge the Father. Sadly, foolish pride can cause mankind to miss out on the redeemer of the world, and therefore never come to know the Father. Only those who put their trust in Christ, for the salvation of their soul, by faith, will not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 8: 21 - 24,....I go my way, and ye shall seek me, and shall die in your sins, whither I go, ye cannot come....if you believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins....

Unbelievers will die in their sins, due to the fact that he is born dead in trespasses and sins and chooses to continue to live his life in sin. Therefore, he becomes a slave to his sin. The believer dies in the Lord, because he has chosen to accept the saving grace of Jesus Christ, and has been given life in the Lord, therefore the power of sin has been severed, and no longer has dominion over his life. God in his foreknowledge and infinite wisdom knows exactly who will choose life and who will choose death. Choosing death means separation from God, an eternity in hell. Choosing life means eternal life in Christ with the Father in heaven. All must face the fact that humanity is running out of time to accept Christ as their savior. At some point, all will realize that they need to seek after Christ and his saving grace, but for many it will be too late.

Luke 16: 23 - 31,... the rich man died and was buried, and being in torments in hell, he lifted up his eyes....then he cries....have mercy on me....

Like the rich man, many will live for the moment and neglect the matters of the heart that prepares us for eternity. Death eventually will come, and steal away any chance of eternal security in Christ, and then it will be to late. The word of God teaches us to, make our lives count for Christ Jesus, to become eternally secure in his salvation, because once we leave this earth, there will be no more chances to secure our eternal life with God.

John 8: 25,....then they said unto him, who art thou....

Christ, from the beginning of time, has not hidden the meaning of who he truly is. Christ, who has equal power to God, equal judgement with God, equal authority as God, has been sent by God, and approved by God. He is the one and only way to come to know and to accept the spiritual truth of salvation. Those who reject him, will never come to know God, and will die in their sins, and be condemned to an eternity in hell. Christ has no need to offer additional proof concerning who he is, due to the fact that all knowledge of Christ, and his existence is written for our learning, in his word. As Christians, we must understand that those who refuse to accept, and continue to ask for more proof of God over and above the word of God, is not being honest concerning their spiritual conviction. The word tells us that, offering more proof will not benefit in their salvation.

Matthew 16: 1-4,....hypocrites....you cannot discern the signs of the times....a wicked and adulterous generation seeks after a sign....

Due to the fear of death, in which mankind and his pride will not permit him to confess Christ as his Lord and Savior, humanity constantly demands a sign to validate that Christ is truly the saving grace of the world. They ask in vain, not truly desiring to acknowledge the existence of Christ, but to discredit and to stop the ministry of the gospel of Jesus Christ. We continue to live in a world with numerous signs of the coming of Christ and sadly these signs are being ignored. This is due to spiritual unfaithfulness, that comes from a generation that only seeks after religious experiences, and emotional and miraculous entertainment, instead of seeking after the truth of the gospel of Jesus Christ. There will be no more signs. The cross, the death, his burial and the resurrection, is the most powerful sign that could have ever been offered has already been given. If this sign cannot convince humanity, then none other ever will.

Revelation 3: 20,....behold I stand at the door and knock, if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come into him, and will sup with him, and he with me....

In the Laodicean church age in which we are living, as Christians we represent Christ, we are his sign of salvation. As the church and the body of Christ, it is our opportunity to knock at the door of the unbeliever, to teach of Christ and the cross and the love that God has given. To tell of the sacrifice made, the resurrection of salvation, and the Holy Spirit that will enter in and establish the relationship that God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit desires to have with each and everyone.

Revelation 3: 21,....to him who overcomes I will grant to sit with me on my throne, as I also overcame and sat down with my Father on his throne....
