I am God

I am appears 300 times in the bible. From Genesis 15: 1 – Revelation 22: 16.

Who is God? This question drives much of human history, and is a driving force throughout the Bible. After the fall of man in Genesis, mankind no longer had direct access to God, and even the people of Israel only knew certain aspects of their Creator. In Exodus, God states His own name for the first time, God said to Moses, 'I AM WHO I AM.' And He said, say this to the people of Israel, I AM has sent me to you. Exodus 3:14....

The name of I AM is how God chose to introduce himself, becoming so sacred that in Judaism, the name is not to be spoken. The significance of God's self-given name encompasses all that He is, and how we are to relate to Him.

The first five books Bible, called the Pentateuch, are historically attributed to Moses. In context, the introduction of the name I AM comes early in Exodus. The Israelites had been in bondage in Egypt for four centuries. Near the end of this time, Moses fled Egypt and lived in Midian for forty years when God came to him and spoke through a burning bush. Moses asks God for His name, so he will have an answer when the people of Israel ask. God's answer is translated as, I AM WHO I AM ... tell them I AM has sent me to you.

Prior to this moment with Moses, the Israelites called their God, Elohim or El or El Shaddai, often translated as God Almighty. When God gives a name for His people to call Him, it conveys His dominion over all things, the source of His power, and His eternal nature, I AM. He is the self-sufficient, self-sustaining God who was, who is, and who will be.

The Hebrew scribes were very careful, to neither say aloud, nor fully spell out the holy and sacred name of God. Instead, they would put it in all capital letters, and say Adonai. They put the vowels of Adonai into the consonants of Yaweh to get YAHOWAH, which English Christians translated into Jehovah. Today, any time a translator wants to acknowledge where YHWH is in the original Hebrew text, they use the word LORD in all capital letters.

Isaiah 8:1,....Then the LORD said to me, take a large tablet and write on it in common characters....

Psalm 149:1,....Praise the LORD! Sing to the Lord a new song, his praise in the assembly of the godly...

Proverbs 21:3,....To do righteousness and justice is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice....

Perhaps the most significant use of the name I AM in the Bible comes from Jesus Christ. The religious leaders would often try to catch Jesus in heresy, in a lie, or blaspheming so they could be rid of him.

In John 8, the Jewish people challenged his authority, and they brought up Abraham. Jesus tells them how glad Abraham is to see the day of the Lord. When asked by the crowd how He speaks as if He knows Abraham, Jesus said to them, Truly, truly I say to you, before Abraham was, I am, John 8:58...

.

While the original statement in the Book of John comes to us in Greek, the context does indicate that Jesus is invoking the divine name of God. First, He is claiming to Abraham, a feat rather difficult for an ordinary man. Second, the Jewish people reacted to this statement by trying to stone Jesus, as described in:

Leviticus 24:15-16,.... And speak to the people of Israel, saying, Who ever curses his God shall bear his sin. Whoever blasphemes the name of the LORD shall surely be put to death. All the congregation shall stone him. The sojourner as well as the native, when he blasphemes the Name, shall be put to death...

The Jewish people took this law seriously and reacted to Christ invoking I AM by trying to carry out the punishment of the Levitical law. To them it was blasphemy, as Christ took the Divine name for Himself.

Understanding the weight and power of the name, I AM WHO I AM is important for today's Christian to see the complexity of who God is. He is all-encompassing and self-sufficient. It is a name above names, one that reminds the believer that God is in control, and that He sees His children. It also affirms the identity of the Savior as the Son of God. It can be easy in the struggles of everyday life to lose sight of the majesty and holiness of God, but meditating on the name that He gave Himself, and all that it represents, can help put our time on earth into perspective. God is infinite, and He is sovereign over our lives, He Is Who He Is.

- Following, are some of the scriptures in the bible that represent God himself as the I am, there are many more scriptures that pertain to God as the I am, but these are direct implications of that statement.
- **Genesis 15:7,....** And he said unto him, I am the LORD that brought thee out of Ur of the Chaldees, to give thee this land to inherit it.
- **Genesis 17:1,....** And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.
- **Genesis 26:24,....** And the LORD appeared unto him the same night, and said, I am the God of Abraham thy father: fear not, for I am with thee, and will bless thee, and multiply thy seed for my servant Abraham's sake.
- **Genesis 28:13,....** And, behold, the LORD stood above it, and said, I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed;
- **Genesis 31:13,....** I am the God of Bethel, where thou anointedst the pillar, and where thou vowedst a vow unto me: now arise, get thee out from this land, and return unto the land of thy kindred.
- **Genesis 35:11,....** And God said unto him, I am God Almighty: be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall be of thee, and kings shall come out of thy loins;
- **Genesis 46:3,....** And he said, I am God, the God of thy father: fear not to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation:
- **Exodus 3:6,....** Moreover he said, I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.
- **Exodus 3:8,....** And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites. And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.
- **Exodus 6:2,....** And God spake unto Moses, and said unto him, I am the LORD:
- **Exodus 6:6,....** Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:
- **Exodus 6:8,....** And I will bring you in unto the land, concerning the which I did swear to give it to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob; and I will give it you for an heritage: I am the LORD.
- **Exodus 6:29,....** That the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, I am the LORD: speak thou unto Pharaoh king of Egypt all that I say unto thee.
- **Exodus 7:5,....** And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I stretch forth mine hand upon Egypt, and bring out the children of Israel from among them.

- **Exodus 7:17,....** Thus saith the LORD, In this thou shalt know that I am the LORD: behold, I will smite with the rod that is in mine hand upon the waters which are in the river, and they shall be turned to blood.
- **Exodus 8:22,....** And I will sever in that day the land of Goshen, in which my people dwell, that no swarms of flies shall be there; to the end thou mayest know that I am the LORD in the midst of the earth.
- **Exodus 10:2,....** And that thou mayest tell in the ears of thy son, and of thy son's son, what things I have wrought in Egypt, and my signs which I have done among them; that ye may know how that I am the LORD.
- **Exodus 12:12,....** For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.
- **Exodus 14:4,....** And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honored upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I am the LORD. And they did so.
- **Exodus 14:18,....** And the Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I have gotten me honor upon Pharaoh, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.
- **Exodus 15:26,....** And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.
- **Exodus 16:12,....** I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel: speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread; and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God.
- **Exodus 20:2,....** I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.
- **Exodus 29:46,....** And they shall know that I am the LORD their God, that brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, that I may dwell among them: I am the LORD their God.
- **Exodus 31:13,....** Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that I am the LORD that doth sanctify you.
- **Leviticus 11:44,....** For I am the LORD your God: ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be holy; for I am holy: neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
- **Leviticus 11:45,....** For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.
- **Leviticus 18:2,....** Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 18:4,....** Ye shall do my judgments, and keep mine ordinances, to walk therein: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 18:5,....** Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my judgments: which if a man do, he shall live in them: I am the LORD. None of you shall approach to any that is near of kin to him, to uncover their nakedness: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 18:21,....** And thou shalt not let any of thy seed pass through the fire to Molech, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 18:30,....** Therefore shall ye keep mine ordinance, that ye commit not any one of these abominable customs, which were committed before you, and that ye defile not yourselves therein: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:3,....** Ye shall fear every man his mother, and his father, and keep my sabbaths: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:4,....** Turn ye not unto idols, nor make to yourselves molten gods: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:10,....** And thou shalt not glean thy vineyard, neither shalt thou gather every grape of thy vineyard; thou shalt leave them for the poor and stranger: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:12,....** And ye shall not swear by my name falsely, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 19:14,....** Thou shalt not curse the deaf, nor put a stumblingblock before the blind, but shalt fear thy God: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 19:16,....** Thou shalt not go up and down as a talebearer among thy people: neither shalt thou stand against the blood of thy neighbour: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 19:18,....** Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 19:25,....** And in the fifth year shall ye eat of the fruit thereof, that it may yield unto you the increase thereof: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:28,....** Ye shall not make any cuttings in your flesh for the dead, nor print any marks upon you: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 19:30,....** Ye shall keep my sabbaths, and reverence my sanctuary: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 19:31,....** Regard not them that have familiar spirits, neither seek after wizards, to be defiled by them: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:32,....** Thou shalt rise up before the hoary head, and honor the face of the old man, and fear thy God: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 19:34,....** But the stranger that dwelleth with you shall be unto you as one born among you, and thou shalt love him as thyself; for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 19:36,....** Just balances, just weights, a just ephah, and a just hin, shall ye have: I am the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt.

**Leviticus 19:37,....** Therefore shall ye observe all my statutes, and all my judgments, and do them: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 20:7,....** Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy: for I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 20:8,....** And ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: I am the LORD which sanctify you.

**Leviticus 20:24,....** But I have said unto you, Ye shall inherit their land, and I will give it unto you to possess it, a land that floweth with milk and honey: I am the LORD your God, which have separated you from other people.

**Leviticus 21:12,....** Neither shall he go out of the sanctuary, nor profane the sanctuary of his God; for the crown of the anointing oil of his God is upon him: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 22:2,....** Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, that they separate themselves from the holy things of the children of Israel, and that they profane not my holy name in those things which they hallow unto me: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 22:3,....** Say unto them, Whosoever he be of all your seed among your generations, that goeth unto the holy things, which the children of Israel hallow unto the LORD, having his uncleanness upon him, that soul shall be cut off from my presence: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 22:8,....** That which dieth of itself, or is torn with beasts, he shall not eat to defile himself therewith: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 22:30,....** On the same day it shall be eaten up; ye shall leave none of it until the morrow: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 22:31,....** Therefore shall ye keep my commandments, and do them: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 22:32,....** Neither shall ye profane my holy name; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: I am the LORD which hallow you,

**Leviticus 22:33,....** That brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 23:22,....** And when ye reap the harvest of your land, thou shalt not make clean riddance of the corners of thy field when thou reapest, neither shalt thou gather any gleaning of thy harvest: thou shalt leave them unto the poor, and to the stranger: I am the LORD your God. That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 24:22,....** Ye shall have one manner of law, as well for the stranger, as for one of your own country: for I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 25:17,....** Ye shall not therefore oppress one another; but thou shalt fear thy God: for I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 25:38,....** I am the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, to give you the land of Canaan, and to be your God.

**Leviticus 25:55,....** For unto me the children of Israel are servants; they are my servants whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 26:1,....** Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the LORD your God.

**Leviticus 26:2,....** Ye shall keep my sabbaths, and reverence my sanctuary: I am the LORD.

**Leviticus 26:13,....** I am the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, that ye should not be their bondmen; and I have broken the bands of your yoke, and made you go upright.

**Leviticus 26:44,....** And yet for all that, when they be in the land of their enemies, I will not cast them away, neither will I abhor them, to destroy them utterly, and to break my covenant with them: for I am the LORD their God.

**Leviticus 26:45,....** But I will for their sakes remember the covenant of their ancestors, whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the heathen, that I might be their God: I am the LORD.

**Numbers 3:13,....** Because all the firstborn are mine; for on the day that I smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt I hallowed unto me all the firstborn in Israel, both man and beast: mine shall they be: I am the LORD.

**Numbers 3:41,....** And thou shalt take the Levites for me (I am the LORD) instead of all the firstborn among the children of Israel; and the cattle of the Levites instead of all the firstlings among the cattle of the children of Israel.

**Numbers 3:45,....** Take the Levites instead of all the firstborn among the children of Israel, and the cattle of the Levites instead of their cattle; and the Levites shall be mine: I am the LORD.

**Numbers 10:10,....** Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial before your God: I am the LORD your God.

**Numbers 15:41,....** I am the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am the LORD your God.

- **Deuteronomy 5:6,....** I am the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.
- **Deuteronomy 29:6,....** Ye have not eaten bread, neither have ye drunk wine or strong drink: that ye might know that I am the LORD your God.
- **Judges 6:10,....** And I said unto you, I am the LORD your God; fear not the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but ye have not obeyed my voice.
- **1 Kings 20:13,....** And, behold, there came a prophet unto Ahab king of Israel, saying, Thus saith the LORD, Hast thou seen all this great multitude? behold, I will deliver it into thine hand this day; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD.
- **1 Kings 20:28,....** And there came a man of God, and spake unto the king of Israel, and said, Thus saith the LORD, Because the Syrians have said, The LORD is God of the hills, but he is not God of the valleys, therefore will I deliver all this great multitude into thine hand, and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Psalms 46:10,....** Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.
- **Psalms 50:7,....** Hear, O my people, and I will speak; O Israel, and I will testify against thee: I am God, even thy God.
- **Psalms 81:10,....** I am the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it.
- **Isaiah 41:4,....** Who hath wrought and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? I the LORD, the first, and with the last; I am he.
- **Isaiah 41:10,....** Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.
- **Isaiah 42:8,....** I am the LORD: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.
- **Isaiah 43:3,....** For I am the LORD thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour: I gave Egypt for thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.
- **Isaiah 43:10,....** Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.
- **Isaiah 43:12,...** I have declared, and have saved, and I have shewed, when there was no strange god among you: therefore ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, that I am God.
- **Isaiah 43:13,....** Yea, before the day was I am he; and there is none that can deliver out of my hand: I will work, and who shall let it?
- Isaiah 43:15,.... I am the LORD, your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King.

- **Isaiah 44:6,...** Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.
- **Isaiah 44:24,....** Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I am the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;
- **Isaiah 45:5,....** I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me:
- **Isaiah 45:6,....** That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. I am the LORD, and there is none else.
- **Isaiah 45:18,....** For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else.
- **Isaiah 45:22,....** Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.
- **Isaiah 46:4,....** And even to your old age I am he; and even to hoar hairs will I carry you: I have made, and I will bear; even I will carry, and will deliver you.
- **Isaiah 46:9,....** Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me,
- **Isaiah 48:12,...** Hearken unto me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; I am he; I am the first, I also am the last.
- **Isaiah 48:17,....** Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.
- **Isaiah 49:23,....** And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with their face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.
- **Isaiah 51:15,....** But I am the LORD thy God, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The LORD of hosts is his name. Therefore my people shall know my name: therefore they shall know in that day that I am he that doth speak: behold, it is I.
- **Jeremiah 9:24,....** But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the LORD.
- **Jeremiah 24:7,....** And I will give them an heart to know me, that I am the LORD: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.

- **Jeremiah 31:9,....** They shall come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim is my firstborn. Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me?
- **Ezekiel 6:7,....** And the slain shall fall in the midst of you, and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 6:10,....** And they shall know that I am the LORD, and that I have not said in vain that I would do this evil unto them.
- **Ezekiel 6:13,....** Then shall ye know that I am the LORD, when their slain men shall be among their idols round about their altars, upon every high hill, in all the tops of the mountains, and under every green tree, and under every thick oak, the place where they did offer sweet savour to all their idols.
- **Ezekiel 6:14,....** So will I stretch out my hand upon them, and make the land desolate, yea, more desolate than the wilderness toward Diblath, in all their habitations: and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 7:4,....** And mine eye shall not spare thee, neither will I have pity: but I will recompense thy ways upon thee, and thine abominations shall be in the midst of thee: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 7:9,....** And mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: I will recompense thee according to thy ways and thine abominations that are in the midst of thee; and ye shall know that I am the LORD that smiteth.
- **Ezekiel 7:27,....** The king shall mourn, and the prince shall be clothed with desolation, and the hands of the people of the land shall be troubled: I will do unto them after their way, and according to their deserts will I judge them; and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 11:10,....** Ye shall fall by the sword; I will judge you in the border of Israel; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 11:12,....** And ye shall know that I am the LORD: for ye have not walked in my statutes, neither executed my judgments, but have done after the manners of the heathen that are round about you.
- **Ezekiel 12:15,....** And they shall know that I am the LORD, when I shall scatter them among the nations, and disperse them in the countries.
- **Ezekiel 12:16,....** But I will leave a few men of them from the sword, from the famine, and from the pestilence; that they may declare all their abominations among the heathen whither they come; and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 12:20,....** And the cities that are inhabited shall be laid waste, and the land shall be desolate; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 12:25,....** For I am the LORD: I will speak, and the word that I shall speak shall come to pass; it shall be no more prolonged: for in your days, O rebellious house, will I say the word, and will perform it, saith the Lord GOD.

- **Ezekiel 13:9,....** And mine hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity, and that divine lies: they shall not be in the assembly of my people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that I am the Lord GOD. So will I break down the wall that ye have daubed with untempered morter, and bring it down to the ground, so that the foundation thereof shall be discovered, and it shall fall, and ye shall be consumed in the midst thereof: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 13:21,....** Your kerchiefs also will I tear, and deliver my people out of your hand, and they shall be no more in your hand to be hunted; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 13:23,....** Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver my people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 14:8,....** And I will set my face against that man, and will make him a sign and a proverb, and I will cut him off from the midst of my people; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 15:7,....** And I will set my face against them; they shall go out from one fire, and another fire shall devour them; and ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I set my face against them.
- **Ezekiel 16:62,....** And I will establish my covenant with thee; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD:
- **Ezekiel 20:5,....** And say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day when I chose Israel, and lifted up mine hand unto the seed of the house of Jacob, and made myself known unto them in the land of Egypt, when I lifted up mine hand unto them, saying, I am the LORD your God;
- **Ezekiel 20:7,....** Then said I unto them, Cast ye away every man the abominations of his eyes, and defile not yourselves with the idols of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.
- **Ezekiel 20:12,....** Moreover also I gave them my sabbaths, to be a sign between me and them, that they might know that I am the LORD that sanctify them.
- **Ezekiel 20:19,....** I am the LORD your God; walk in my statutes, and keep my judgments, and do them;
- **Ezekiel 20:20,....** And hallow my sabbaths; and they shall be a sign between me and you, that ye may know that I am the LORD your God.
- **Ezekiel 20:26,....** And I polluted them in their own gifts, in that they caused to pass through the fire all that openeth the womb, that I might make them desolate, to the end that they might know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 20:38,....** And I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

- **Ezekiel 20:42,....** And ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I shall bring you into the land of Israel, into the country for the which I lifted up mine hand to give it to your fathers.
- **Ezekiel 20:44,....** And ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I have wrought with you for my name's sake, not according to your wicked ways, nor according to your corrupt doings, O ye house of Israel, saith the Lord GOD.
- **Ezekiel 22:16,....** And thou shalt take thine inheritance in thyself in the sight of the heathen, and thou shalt know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 23:49,....** And they shall recompense your lewdness upon you, and ye shall bear the sins of your idols: and ye shall know that I am the Lord GOD.
- **Ezekiel 24:24,....** Thus Ezekiel is unto you a sign: according to all that he hath done shall ye do: and when this cometh, ye shall know that I am the Lord GOD.
- **Ezekiel 24:27,....** In that day shall thy mouth be opened to him which is escaped, and thou shalt speak, and be no more dumb: and thou shalt be a sign unto them; and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 25:5,....** And I will make Rabbah a stable for camels, and the Ammonites a couchingplace for flocks: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 25:7,....** Behold, therefore I will stretch out mine hand upon thee, and will deliver thee for a spoil to the heathen; and I will cut thee off from the people, and I will cause thee to perish out of the countries: I will destroy thee; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 25:11,....** And I will execute judgments upon Moab; and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 25:17,....** And I will execute great vengeance upon them with furious rebukes; and they shall know that I am the LORD, when I shall lay my vengeance upon them.
- **Ezekiel 26:6,....** And her daughters which are in the field shall be slain by the sword; and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 28:22,....** And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against thee, O Zidon; and I will be glorified in the midst of thee: and they shall know that I am the LORD, when I shall have executed judgments in her, and shall be sanctified in her.
- **Ezekiel 28:23,....** For I will send into her pestilence, and blood into her streets; and the wounded shall be judged in the midst of her by the sword upon her on every side; and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 28:24,....** And there shall be no more a pricking brier unto the house of Israel, nor any grieving thorn of all that are round about them, that despised them; and they shall know that I am the Lord GOD.
- **Ezekiel 28:26,....** And they shall dwell safely therein, and shall build houses, and plant vineyards; yea, they shall dwell with confidence, when I have executed judgments upon all those that despise them round about them; and they shall know that I am the LORD their God.

- **Ezekiel 29:6,....** And all the inhabitants of Egypt shall know that I am the LORD, because they have been a staff of reed to the house of Israel.
- **Ezekiel 29:9,....** And the land of Egypt shall be desolate and waste; and they shall know that I am the LORD: because he hath said, The river is mine, and I have made it.
- **Ezekiel 29:16,....** And it shall be no more the confidence of the house of Israel, which bringeth their iniquity to remembrance, when they shall look after them: but they shall know that I am the Lord GOD.
- **Ezekiel 29:21,....** In that day will I cause the horn of the house of Israel to bud forth, and I will give thee the opening of the mouth in the midst of them; and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 30:8,....** And they shall know that I am the LORD, when I have set a fire in Egypt, and when all her helpers shall be destroyed.
- **Ezekiel 30:19,....** Thus will I execute judgments in Egypt: and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 30:25,....** But I will strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, and the arms of Pharaoh shall fall down; and they shall know that I am the LORD, when I shall put my sword into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall stretch it out upon the land of Egypt.
- **Ezekiel 30:26,....** And I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations, and disperse them among the countries; and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 32:15,....** When I shall make the land of Egypt desolate, and the country shall be destitute of that whereof it was full, when I shall smite all them that dwell therein, then shall they know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 33:29,....** Then shall they know that I am the LORD, when I have laid the land most desolate because of all their abominations which they have committed.
- **Ezekiel 34:27,....** And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them.
- **Ezekiel 34:31,....** And ye my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, saith the Lord GOD.
- **Ezekiel 35:4,....** I will lay thy cities waste, and thou shalt be desolate, and thou shalt know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 35:9,....** I will make thee perpetual desolations, and thy cities shall not return: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 35:12,....** And thou shalt know that I am the LORD, and that I have heard all thy blasphemies which thou hast spoken against the mountains of Israel, saying, They are laid desolate, they are given us to consume.

- **Ezekiel 35:15,....** As thou didst rejoice at the inheritance of the house of Israel, because it was desolate, so will I do unto thee: thou shalt be desolate, O mount Seir, and all Idumea, even all of it: and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 36:11,....** And I will multiply upon you man and beast; and they shall increase and bring fruit: and I will settle you after your old estates, and will do better unto you than at your beginnings: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 36:23,....** And I will sanctify my great name, which was profaned among the heathen, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the heathen shall know that I am the LORD, saith the Lord GOD, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes. As the holy flock, as the flock of Jerusalem in her solemn feasts; so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of men: and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 37:6,....** And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 37:13,....** And ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves,
- **Ezekiel 38:23,....** Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 39:6,....** And I will send a fire on Magog, and among them that dwell carelessly in the isles: and they shall know that I am the LORD.
- **Ezekiel 39:7,....** So will I make my holy name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not let them pollute my holy name any more: and the heathen shall know that I am the LORD, the Holy One in Israel.
- **Ezekiel 39:22,....** So the house of Israel shall know that I am the LORD their God from that day and forward.
- **Ezekiel 39:28,....** Then shall they know that I am the LORD their God, which caused them to be led into captivity among the heathen: but I have gathered them unto their own land, and have left none of them any more there.
- **Hosea 11:9,....** I will not execute the fierceness of mine anger, I will not return to destroy Ephraim: for I am God, and not man; the Holy One in the midst of thee: and I will not enter into the city.
- **Hosea 13:4,....** Yet I am the LORD thy God from the land of Egypt, and thou shalt know no god but me: for there is no saviour beside me.
- **Joel 2:27,....** And ye shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am the LORD your God, and none else: and my people shall never be ashamed.
- **Joel 3:17,....** So shall ye know that I am the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain: then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more.

**Zechariah 10:6,....** And I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I am the LORD their God, and will hear them.

**Malachi 3:6,....** For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

**Matthew 16:15,....** He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am?

**Matthew 22:32,....** I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.

**Matthew 27:43,....** He trusted in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the Son of God.

**Mark 12:26,....** And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him, saying, I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?

**Mark 14:62,....** And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

**Luke 9:18,....** And it came to pass, as he was alone praying, his disciples were with him: and he asked them, saying, Whom say the people that I am?

**Luke 9:20,....** He said unto them, But whom say ye that I am? Peter answering said, The Christ of God.

**Luke 22:70,....** Then said they all, Art thou then the Son of God? And he said unto them, Ye say that I am.

**John 6:35,....** And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

John 6:48,.... I am that bread of life.

**John 6:51,...** I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

**John 8:12,....** Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

**John 8:18,....** I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.

**John 8:24,...** I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.

**John 8:28,....** Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.

**John 8:58,....** Jesus said unto them, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

John 9:9,.... Some said, This is he: others said, He is like him: but he said, I am he.

**John 9:39,....** And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind. Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep.

**John 10:9,....** I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.

John 10:11,.... I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

John 10:14,.... I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.

**John 10:36,....** Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?

**John 11:25,....** Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

John 13:13,.... Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.

**John 13:19,....** Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I am he.

**John 15:1,...** I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

**John 15:5,....** I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

**John 18:5,....** They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, I am he. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them.

**John 18:6,....** As soon then as he had said unto them, I am he, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

**John 18:8,....** Jesus answered, I have told you that I am he: if therefore ye seek me, let these go their way:

**Acts 7:32,....** Saying, I am the God of thy fathers, the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. Then Moses trembled, and durst not behold.

**Acts 9:5,....** And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.

**Acts 22:8,....** And I answered, Who art thou, Lord? And he said unto me, I am Jesus of Nazareth, whom thou persecutest.

**Acts 26:15,....** And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest.

**1 Peter 1:16,....** Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

**Revelation 1:8,....** I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

**Revelation 1:11,....** Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

**Revelation 1:17,....** And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:

**Revelation 1:18,....** I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

**Revelation 2:23,....** And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

**Revelation 21:6,....** And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. Then saith he unto me, See thou do it not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.

**Revelation 22:13,....** I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

**Revelation 22:16,....** I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star.

God wants to assure his children that he would become what they would need Him to become. In using the words, I AM THAT I AM, God used an expression to reveal to us a promise and a pledge found in His name.

The words, I AM THAT I AM, which should more accurately be translated, I will be what I will be, or as it is translated, I will become whatsoever I may become. This expression is an expression that has a meaning that cannot be understood by the wickedness of this world.

By using the translation, I will become whatsoever I may become, we see the relationship of this phrase to God. They both use the word, which was God's way of assuring and pledging to mankind that God would become whatever they needed Him to become.

When God provided the promise that He would become what they would need Him to become it means that he would become our deliverer. This promise found in the name of God is extended to all of mankind. God will become what they need Him to become, and that is the one that provides for the plan of salvation, that will bring humanity back into harmony with Him. In the case of the church, God will be all that we need to make our calling and election sure.

The aim of all ministry is the advancement and joy of our faith, to the glory of God.

Philippians 1: 19 - 26,....according to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I shall be ashamed....and being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue....

Preaching is one means to that end, and therefore when we teach or preach, we look for things that will stir up our hearts and mind, so as to trust God with all your heart.

Psalm 9: 10,....and those who know your name will put their trust in you, for you Lord, have not forsaken those who seek you....

Those who believe in and know God's name will trust him. The Lord will strengthen our confidence in him, so that in our life together with him, we might help others know the name and power of God. Those who truly know Gods name will put their trust in him.

Matthew 1: 21,.... You shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins

Knowing the name of God will help us trust him with our daily affairs and with our eternal destinies. And when the Son of God came into the world, his name was not left to chance.

Now there is a big difference between us and God. In naming someone, we do not have the power or the authority to make the person fit the name. But God has the right, and the power to allow anyone that he names to become what that name implies. The names that he gives is a sure indicator of the destiny of those he names.

He chooses names for the sake of revealing things about himself that will deepen our love for him and enlarge our admiration and strengthen our faith.

So, our prayer is that the message of Gods word will open our eyes to his glory, and enlarge our acquaintance with his magnificent character, and fan the flames of our love, and strengthen every fiber of our faith. Our hope is in the word of God.

Revelation 3: 12,....He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of my God, and he will not go out from it anymore, and I will write on him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from my God, and my new name....

So here is why we must spend a lot of time meditating on the word of God. What does it mean when you ask your God, Who are you? and he answers, I AM WHO I AM? I hope you can begin to feel how important these words are. There are not any words more important than these, because these words are true. The more you ponder them, the more awesome they become.
