## Isaiah 9: 6 – 7, John 12: 12 – 16

The entry of Christ into Jerusalem offers up many similarities to the happenings that is going on within the body of Christ throughout this grace dispensation period. The prophets of old had predicted a coming messiah, and that his time was at hand. The word of God now promises unto all who will believe, a returning savior, who's appearance will attract the attention of the entire world. Humanity has always gathered together, seeking for one who will deliver them, sadly, it is not to deliver them from sinfulness, but to deliver them from the consequences of that sinfulness, of which they have no understanding. As believers, we know Christ, but do we fully understand why he came to the earth, and do we understand the fulfillment of that coming. Christ came to provide us with a real likeness of who God is, and to sacrifice himself in our place, to pay our sin debt. He set aside the power and strength that was rightfully his and became as one of humanity in the form of a man, so that we might understand why he came, and so that we might accept his invitation to, enter into an eternal relationship with the Father. Christ time on earth was to fulfill Gods plan of salvation, just as the time of the church upon earth is to fulfill his plan of salvation. These opportunities, which are one in the same, is so that the ability given is utilized to seek out those who need the saving grace of Jesus Christ and to do so without allowing humanities reputation of sinfulness to be a reason to avoid sharing the gospel of Christ with them. Even today, Christ continues, through the work of the church, to seek and to save those who will humbly place their faith in him.

Hebrews 2: 9,....but we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the glory of death, crowned with glory and honor, that by the grace of God should taste death for every man....

Christ birth into a human life upon this earth allowed him to fully experience our struggles. This allows him to respond unto us with compassion, and also allows him to serve as conqueror over sin. John 12: 12 – 16,....much people....come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem....took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna, blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord....fear not....behold thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt....these things understood not his disciples....but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they these things....

As disciples of Christ, we often time do not comprehend many of Christ teachings, due to the fact that we become confused concerning the calling of our salvation. Thankfully, because of the cross, Christ crucifixion and resurrection, we receive the fullness of the leadership and guidance of the Holy Spirit to portray unto us the truth of all that God desires for us in our life.
