A Victorious Kingdom

## **Mark 3: 13 – 19, 6: 6 – 13**

**1 John 5: 4 – 5,....**whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world, and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith....who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?....

We are taught by Gods word that those who have believed have already been given victory. So, why is it that we still see Christians today going through life, living in defeat, and never getting to experience the fullness of Gods promises. This is because we do not live by the authority of God in obedience to his word. We must learn to first recognize Gods power, and then access and apply that power and authority to our lives, in order to walk in the victory of his saving grace. When we fail to operate in the power and authority that God has given unto us, our spiritual life becomes weak, and our desire to follow Gods purpose and plan for our life becomes empty and defeated. The truth is that we have a choice, and although it is hard to believe that anyone would choose to live a life of defeat, which would be a life in which God did not choose for us, because through his word he encourages us to choose to believe, by faith, in His Son, Jesus Christ, so that we might live a life of victory.

**1 Corinthians 15: 57,....**but thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ....

There are two very important statements in God's word that help us to identify with the characteristics of our assurance of being a part of a victorious kingdom. The first is when Christ himself said: It is finished, and the second being when the angel of the Lord proclaimed: He is risen.

**John 19: 28,....**when Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, it is finished....

**Mark 28: 16,....**he is not hear, for he is risen....

Christ paid the full price of mankind's sin debt upon the cross and broke the hold of the power of eternal death when he was resurrected from the grave.

**Romans 8: 1,....**There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the spirit....

The wrath of judgement and condemnation that mankind rightfully deserves was paid in full with the blood of Christ at the cross. The wrath that we deserved, God poured out on his Son, Christ, as a payment for sin. Therefore, whosoever believes in Christ, whosoever has been born again, whosoever has been sealed by the spirit, and whosoever has trusted the Lord Jesus Christ as their savior, will not be condemned.

Condemnation, or Justification comes unto us by the choices in which we make. If we trust in Christ as our savior, there is no condemnation. If we do not trust in Christ as our savior, then there will be condemnation.

Those who are in Christ claim the fullness of his victory. Just as one offense resulted in condemnation for all mankind, so one humble act of righteousness gives unto humanity the opportunity of justification unto eternal life with God.

**Romans 5: 17,....**for if by one man's offense death reigned by one, much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ....

The great gift of salvation is available, and offered in its entirety to all, who become identified with Christ, the righteous man, and his sacrificial act.

**Mark 3: 13 – 19,....**he goeth up into a mountain, and calleth unto him who he would, and they came unto him....he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach....to have power to heal....to cast out devils....Simon....surnamed Peter....James....John....Andrew....Philip....Bartholomew....Matthew....Thomas....James....Thaddaeus....Simon....Judas....

Before Christ done anything upon this earth, he prayed to the Father, and the choices in which he made concerning the twelve, which he ordained, was not just about the characteristics of the twelve that he chose, but his choices were in consideration for all of humanity. Christ knew that the successful future of the ministry of the gospel of the saving grace, which would come forth through him, this success depended upon the chosen twelve, and their willingness of obedience. For this reason, Christ depended upon his heavenly Father when making all decisions.

**Psalms 62: 1 – 8,....**truly my soul waiteth upon God, from him cometh my salvation....he only is my rock and my salvation, he is my defense, I shall not be greatly moved....my soul, wait thou only upon God, for my expectation is from him....he only is my rock and my salvation, he is my defense, I shall not be moved....in God is my salvation and my glory, the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God....trust in him at all times....pour out your heart before him, God is a refuge....

Often time, we come to a place in our life, when the only thing that will make a difference is prayer and depending upon God. God can do in a single moment, what we cannot accomplish in a lifetime. One of the most common mistakes that we make is depending and relying upon our own strength, even when we know that there is no doubt about the power, might, and ability of God to help us. When we go to God in prayer, and place every aspect of life in his hands, through faith believing, God can, and will handle all things in our life as we depend upon him.

**Mark 6: 6 – 13,....**he went....teaching....he called unto him the twelve, and began to send them forth....and commanded that they should take nothing for their journey....they went out, and preached that men should repent....

Before God can effectively use us, we must shew him that we totally depend upon him. We must trust that God will provide for us, physically and more so spiritually. God wants us to focus on the ministry that he has in store for us. This we cannot do if we are worrying about our physical needs above that which is spiritual.

The hope for all mankind is that every true believer would give themselves totally unto God for his service. No work that we seek to do for the Lord can be successful without the power and authority of Christ. Therefore, Christ will supply all that is needed for the success of his ministry, to the ones in whom he sends out.

**John 5: 30,....**I can of mine own self do nothing, as I hear, I judge, and my judgement is just, because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me....

As Christians, we strive for unity with God. This means that our works will have a love to see others experience eternal life over spiritual death. The only way that we can justify our living example is to connect it to the will of God. Christ said that some things only he could speak of, because he alone knew these things through his relationship with the Father. Through Christ, we now have the same identity as Christ, but it is not an opportunity to boast, but an opportunity to tell others how to gain access to Gods victorious kingdom. Remember, we are sent to teach, and to preach, and to be a living example to the world, but only Christ can make the change in the lives of mankind.
