Will Ye Weary My God

Isaiah 7: 7, 10 - 14

Many times, in our lives as believers, God will provide solutions to situations and circumstances in our life, and these solutions that he provides are given unto us through the commandments and promises of his word. Now often time, instead of accepting these solutions as gifts from God, we begin to question the instructions that are given unto us by him, and we do so because, in our minds we doubt, we doubt that these promises will lead us to a victorious, and glorious outcome. Therefore, since as believers, we do not want to seem as if we are questioning God, we question whether or not we understand the motivation behind the promises that he has given unto us. Therefore, instead of remaining in a state of self-confusion, we are encouraged to remain faithful in prayer, and in the study of Gods word, so that we might receive the understanding needed to continue seeking after his will.

Isaiah 40: 28,....hast thou not known? Hast thou not heard that the everlasting God, the Lord, the creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? There is no searching of his understanding....

As believers, often time we wander in unbelief, and we need to be reminded who God is. Now, no one can claim that they did not know about God, for God has revealed himself through all that he has created, therefore, all are accountable unto him. Now, for us as believers, who have known, and who have heard, we should never think that our ways are hidden from God, for there is nothing hidden from his presence, for he understands, and knows all things, therefore, his understanding is unsearchable. Now, there is no way that the limits of Gods understanding could ever be discovered. So, why is it that in the midst of the situations and circumstances in our lives, why do we question Gods faithfulness to us, for we should never allow our lack of faith to become an opportunity to question Gods faithfulness toward us, because when we do, we begin to weary God.

Isaiah 7: 7, 10 - 14,....thus saith the Lord, it shall not stand, neither shall it come to pass....moreover the Lord spake....ask thee a sign of the Lord....ask it either in the depth, or in the height above....hear ye now....it is a small thing for you to weary men, but will you weary my God....therefore, the Lord himself will give you a sign....

As believers, there are many lessons to be learned on our pathway to the spiritual maturity in our life in Christ, and one of the greatest lessons to be learned, is one of not allowing the worldly emotion of fear to control the outcome of the decisions that we make in our life. Now, by what means does God help us to overcome our worldly emotions of fear. He does so by revealing unto us the reasons why we do not have to be afraid, for he shows unto us the weaknesses of that which we fear, so that we might know that by his wisdom, his knowledge, and his understanding, we can be more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Romans 8: 35 - 39,....who shall separate us from the love of God....as it is written, for thy sake, we are killed all the day long....nay, in all we are more than conquerors through him that loved us....for I am persuaded.....(that nothing) shall be able to separate us from the love of God....

Now, why is the question, who shall separate us from the love of God presented unto mankind. For you and I know, that as believers, nothing can separate us from Gods love, but yet, daily, we allow the situations and circumstances of our everyday life to hinder our relationship with God. Even though I know that nothing can separate us from the love of God, that does not necessarily mean that I am fully persuaded to believe it. And even though my hope is in looking forward to an eternal life with God, at the same time, we are not there yet, for it is so hard to patiently wait for that hope to be fulfilled. Therefore, when sufferings come about in our life, instead of asking, by faith believing, through the confidence given unto us by the power of the Holy Spirit, with a heart that is submission to the instruction of Gods word, we ask, but we do so by giving God the answer that we want to hear. We weary God by trying to persuade him that we know what is best for us in our life. The key to our hope of truly knowing that nothing can separate us from the love of God begins when we allow ourselves to be persuaded of God, and not by trying to persuade God to do things our way.

James 4: 3,....ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts....

Living according to the wisdom of the world does not reflect a life in which we trust in God to provide all that we need. We believe in God, but we do not trust that he will provide for us. How often do we go to God in prayer, but our soul desire is to try and manipulate him, so that he will answer our request in a way that will only serve our own selfish desires. So here is what we must do, we must establish in our mind that God will not allow himself to be used to serve our worldly envies and ambitions just so that we might acquire the things that we so desire. We are attempting to use prayer to fulfill our own worldly, lustful desires. Therefore, through his word, God gives unto us direction and instruction on how that we should pray.

Ephesians 6: 18,.... praying always with all prayer and supplication in the spirit, and watching there unto with all perseverance and supplication....

Prayer is meant to connect us to the power of God, and not to be used to manipulate, and weary God. So as believers, we are to pray in the spirit.

Romans 8: 26,....for we know not what we should pray....but the spirit itself maketh intercession for us....

Therefore, our prayers are not merely our thoughts or desires, but they are requests that we make known unto God through the submission to the Holy Spirit who indwells within us.

As believers, we must speak with God persistently. Now, this does not mean that we are praying every moment that we are awake, but it does mean that we recognize that it is never a good thing to set our prayers aside just to follow after our own worldly emotional feelings. Prayer is a way of expressing our needs unto God and knowing that we are not able to satisfy those needs on our own. Our prayer life is only as good as our relationship with God, therefore, the only limitations to our fellowship with God are the ones which we allow, through the choices which we make. Prayer is not so much what we say, but how we say it. It means praying for those things in which the Holy Spirit leads us to pray for and understanding that we are already in submission to God. So, how do we weary God, and how do we overcome that aspect of our life in Christ so that we do not weary God.

Malachi 2: 17,....ye have wearied the Lord with your words....when ye say, everyone that doeth evil is good in the sight of the Lord, and he delighteth in them....

Psalm 142: 1-2, 5-6,....I cried unto the Lord....with my voice unto the Lord did I make my supplication....I poured out my complaint before him, I shewed before him my trouble....I said, thou art my refuge and my portion.... Deliver me from my persecutors, for they are stronger than I.

When all else fails, God reminds us, that when in our struggles he alone remains our unfailing source of strength and hope. Recognizing that he is aware of our struggles encourages us as believers to trust that he has the ability to restore, and to deliver us in our time of need. Therefore, we must confess that God is all that we need in our life, he is our all-sufficient portion. When we cry out to God, it must be in humility and sincerity through the truth of his word, for it is only his word that remains unchanged in this sinful wicked world. His promises are faithful and true, and we know that in the end he will deliver his servants by his faith. Therefore, will we weary God, or will we follow the sign which he has given.
