Christlike Forgiveness

## Philemon 1: 4 – 6, 17 - 19

Do we as believers base our actions on how others treat us, and do we often time regard the way that we live our lives in comparison to how others live theirs? If so, the results that it produces is going to be damaging to our life in Christ. For either we are going to feel inferior to those who we have compared ourselves to, or we are going to have the attitude that we are better than those around us. This is why God must be the standard that we are to measure our life against, for by doing so we will see the value of working together in the unity of the body of Christ, always seeing the need to look for ways to serve others.

**Colossians 3: 23,....** whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men....

**1 Peter 3: 8,....** be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous....

Contrary to what we might often think, every believer is capable of doing something for the Lord, and every believers contribution in Christ is valued. We all have a vital and important role in the body of Christ, for this reason we must not lose focus on the work that God has called unto us to do.

**Philemon 1: 4 – 6,....**I thank my God, making mention of thee always in my prayers, hearing of thy love and faith....toward the Lord....toward all saints....that the communication of thy faith may become effectual....in you in Christ Jesus....

Developing godly love and compassion for one another in the body of Christ is a step in the right direction in our spiritual maturity. As we spiritually mature in our life in Christ, our focus quickly changes from that of living only for ourselves to that of encouraging one another to live complete and productive lives in the Lord. Coming into a deeper knowledge and understanding of Gods grace, through his word, will help us in becoming an affective witness in sharing our faith with others. Therefore, let us never forget that all we are, and all that has come unto us by Christ, and Christ alone, and we are to live our lives before others by the knowledge of every good thing that he has instilled within us by and through the indwelling Holy Spirit.

**2 Corinthians 3: 5,....**not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything of ourselves, but are sufficiency is of God....

When it comes to our life in Christ, how confident are we in our salvation. We must have absolute confidence in knowing that our testimony of representing Christ comes from God, for we are not sufficient of ourselves. It is only by Gods power that we can deliver Gods message to the people that God wants us to reach. When we finally realize that we can do nothing of ourselves, this will remove the burden of pressure that we have put upon ourselves, as we are try to live Christlike in a world that is without Christ.

**Romans 10: 9,....**if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved....

We cannot receive any greater confidence than this in our life. By faith believing in Christ, we who were once useless to God, by his saving grace, we are transformed into a people who now produces profitable, godly service. So, this means that through Christ, we have now become who he has created us to be, and by the word of God our status in life has now changed, for we have now become a new creation in him. Through the forgiveness, which we have received from Christ, we are now able ( pay attention ) to extend that same forgiveness unto others, for we have been forgiven of much more than what any other could ever do unto us.

**Romans 8: 28,....**and we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose....

The promise, that God works all things together for good, does not mean that all things are always going to be good, neither does it mean that we will acquire all that we desire, but it does mean that God is able to work everything that is going on in our life for his good, for our life now is all about the goodness of God, and our confidence in him proves that his purpose and plan for our life will work in such a manner as he sees fit. This means that even when things in our life seems out of control, God is still in control.

**Romans 8: 35, 38 – 39,....**who shall separate us from the love of Christ?....for I am persuaded....( that nothing )....shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord....

As believers, we now have the assurance that nothing can separate us from Gods love, for his love is everlasting, and his wisdom is eternal. So, what did Paul say that we learn from all of this. First of all, we learn that we cannot out give God, so this makes forgiveness one of our greatest characteristics as a believer.

**Philemon 1: 17 – 19,....**if thou count me....a partner, receive him ( Onesimus ) as myself....if he hath wronged thee, or oweth thee ought, put that on my account....I will repay it....

As believers, who have received God's forgiveness, are we willing, through fervent obedience, are we willing to show forth forgiveness through the kindness of the love which God has instilled within us, are we willing to show this unto others. So, we might ask ourselves why should we be willing to show forgiveness unto others, I can tell you why, for Gods kindness of forgiveness is meant to lead people to repentance, and our kindness reflects the heart of God, which allows us to share with others our faith, through the work of the Holy Spirit, which dwells within us, and in doing so it will yield fruit, both in our lives, and in the lives of those around us.

**Titus 3: 4 – 8,....**but after that the kindness and love of God our savior toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing....and renewing of the Holy Ghost, which he shed on us....through Jesus Christ our savior....this is a faithful saying....that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works....these things are good and profitable unto men....

Gods' truth, which is the truth of his word is not only the foundation of our relationship with him, but it is also the foundation of our relationship with other believers. What a privilege it is for us, as believers, to genuinely live Christlike in front of others, and we do so by living in his unfailing love. The strongest testimony that we can show forth to every person in our life, is by living our life in such a way that the love which we express is a love that shines forth on behalf of the Lord Jesus Christ, for this is the evidence of Christ at work in our lives that encourages us to live according to the obedience of God's word. As believers, one of the greatest invitations that we can receive is the invitation to forgive someone that we feel has wronged us. This ultimate test of our salvation is an opportunity to allow the characteristics of God to shine forth unto others in the form of Christlike forgiveness.

**Titus 3: 5**,....not by works of righteousness that we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us....

That is true Christlike forgiveness.
