Considering Our Ways

Haggai 1: 1 − 7

Let us to ask ourselves this question, is it our time, or is it Gods time? Does our spiritual worldly desires outweigh or take precedence over the desires that God has intended for us in our life? Our personal desires can mislead us when we strive to fulfill our own agenda and gain material wealth in the world. Gaining material wealth will give unto us a false sense of success, and because of it we will have to endure an even greater filling of emptiness that will come, because of it. For this reason, we will never be truly happy because we will have missed out on what God wanted most for us in our life. So, how do we know if the desires of our heart are pure? This comes through obedience to Gods word. If we are truly obedient to God and to his word, and if all that we do gives us delight through his word, and if what we do gives us joy because it is pleasing unto God and follows his priorities, then and only then that which we desire in our heart, and that which we want most in our life will be the same as that which God is blessing us with. One thing that we do not want to do is to come to the end of our life and discover that we have gained the whole world while forfeiting our own soul.

Matthew 16: 26,....for what is a man propheted, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

As believers, we must be willing to deny our own wants and desires, giving up every part of our own agenda and totally submitting to the will of God and his purpose in our life, and also for the spiritual maturing of the body of Christ. Earthly success can only last until our physical death. So, before this happens, we all must choose, either to lose everything that we are in the world, so that we might follow Christ and be eternally saved, or keep all that we are in the world, continuing to serve our own lustful desires, and lose our soul forever in eternal condemnation.

Haggai 1: 1-7,....in the second year of Darius the king....came the word of the Lord, by Haggai the prophet....thus speaketh the Lord of host....the people say, the time is not come....then came the word of the Lord, by Haggai the prophet....is it time for you....thus saith the Lord....consider your ways....ye have sown much, and bring in little, ye eat, but have not enough, ye drink, but ye are not filled....ye clothe you, but there is none warm....earneth wages to put in a bag with holes....thus saith the Lord....consider your ways....

How is it, that as believers, that we can say that we live for God, but we do not have spiritual works. We use excuse after excuse and blame God for our lack of opportunity and works, because we claim that his timing has not yet come. This is not spiritual reasoning, but it is worldly reasoning that we use for an excuse of our unwillingness to do Gods will. We have replaced the priority of Gods will in our life with the desire of our own personal preferences. This means that Gods work in our life has taken a second place to our own desires. So, we must ask ourselves the question, is it time for us, which means are we living for ourselves, and if this is so then we must consider our ways.

Romans 14: 7 - 8,....for none of us liveth to himself, and no man dieth to himself....for whether we live, we live unto the Lord, and whether we die, we die unto the Lord, whether we live thereof, or die, we are the Lords....

No matter what happens in our life, each one of us should be fully secured in our position in Christ. As believers, we have been given great liberties in Christ, and with this liberty we are entrusted by him to make wise and godly decisions. It is very important that we live our lives in service to God, and do everything for his greater glory. Our life should be so committed to God, that he is everything to us, and we ourselves are nothing.

Galatians 5: 1,....stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage....

In this prophecy that is given unto Haggai, we as believers are warned, not once, but twice, to consider our ways. We are challenged to prioritize our actions, for we live our lives according to the path in which we have chosen to travel. Therefore, by his word God tells us to re-evaluate our ways and make those changes, which are necessary, to get our life in Christ in line with the promises of God's word. For it is because we try to provide for ourselves that we miss out on the blessings of God, and because God is displeased with our thoughts and our actions, he will show unto us his displeasure by withholding his blessings from us, and even though we believe that we are sowing plentifully, we are not reaping the benefits of our work, and this is because we have allowed something other than God to become a priority in our life.

Isaiah 46: 9-11,....remember....I am God, and there is none else, I am God, and there is none like me....declaring the end from the beginning....I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass, I have purposed it, I will also do it....

The most important thing in our life is to accomplish the will of God. To do this, God gives unto us specific instructions to follow, and with these instructions he gives unto us the ability to fulfill his will. Our obedience to following Gods instruction will give him pleasure and glorify him. As we become obedient to God, he will lead us and guide us through the indwelling Holy Spirit. Now, often time, God will lead us in a direction without giving us a clear indication as to why, which means that along with obedience, we also need great faith, and great understanding. Then when, by faith, we follow his leadership and guidance, even when we do not have a clear indication of his direction, this is when we begin to grow in our understanding of God and his eternal plan for us.

Proverbs 4: 1-7,....hear....the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding...let thine heart return my words, keep my commandments, and live....get wisdom, get understanding, forget it not....wisdom is the principle thing, therefore get wisdom, and with all thy getting, get understanding....

All of humanity sets goals and they work hard to reach them. But all of these objectives will fade away in comparison to the value of acquiring spiritual wisdom and understanding from God. For there is nothing more valuable to mankind then the wisdom to know God, to do his will, and to understand how to respond to his opportunities. We will pursue many things in our life, but true satisfaction comes only from knowing God. Godly wisdom and understanding gives unto us the ability to choose the correct solution for any situation in our life. This means knowing how to think, how to speak, and how to act, so that we might please God throughout the entirety of our life here upon this earth. Without wisdom, knowledge, and understanding, mankind is easily deceived and led astray, which can cause confusion when it comes to following the direction that God would have us to go in our life.

When this begins to happen our level of increase will not measure up to what we had hoped for, and it is for this reason that God will leave no doubt in our mind that he is withholding his blessings from us. God does this to get our attention, and to persuade us to change. We are to change from looking out for our own interest which causes us to ignore the things that glorify God. If we are to become faithful to the call of Gods service, we must learn to be obedient, taking action only in those things which God has promised unto us through his word.

Colossians 2: 1-3,....that their hearts might be comforted....of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ, in whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge....

So, why should we as believers consider our ways, because the efforts of others first begin within our own efforts of success to glorify God within the body of Christ. This success will then encourage others, for now others will begin to see the positive spiritual growth that they have been hearing about through the word of God, now gaining the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledging of the mystery of God in their own lives, which is the saving grace of Jesus Christ.
