Nothing Is Hidden From God

Psalm 139: 1 - 16

As believers, are we comforted by the fact that God knows all things or are we fearful. Just having wisdom, and knowledge of an all-knowing God can bring about both comfort and fear in our life in Christ. The comfort comes from the assurance that Gods perfect knowledge of us means that he is aware of our needs, and that he has a plan and a purpose for our life. The fear that arises in our life comes when we realize that God knows our every thought and our every action, including those things that are a result of our disobedience when we are not living according to his will. So, by spending time in prayer, and in Gods word, we can better understand the nature of God, and instead of being afraid of the knowledge of God, we can use the fact that God knows all things, in order to trust that his infinite knowledge is for our good, and for his glory, and not for condemnation. This in turn will give unto us a sense of reverence that will put all things into their proper place in our life in Christ, so that our relationship will continue to grow stronger day by day.

Hebrews 4: 13,....neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight, but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do....

Nothing is hidden from Gods sight, for everything is uncovered and laid bare before his presence, and even when it feels like no one understands the things that we are going through, God does. God sees us, and he understands us, and no matter what he sees and understands about us, his love for us always remains. Yes, even though we might doubt his goodness because of the things that are going on in our life, he still loves us. Therefore, let us live with the truthfulness of knowing that nothing remains hidden from God, and that everyone will one day stand before him to give an account of our lives.

Psalm 139: 1-4,....O Lord, thou hast searched me, and known me....thou knowest my downsitting and my uprising, thou understandeth my thoughts afar off....thou compasseth my path and my laying down, and art acquainted with all my ways....for there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O Lord, thou knowest it altogether....

For the entirety of our life, from every action to every thought, even the words that are not yet spoken, brings to our thoughts an amazement of knowledge that is often time too vast for the human mind to grasp. So, what is the reality of Gods awareness. For us, as believers, it gives unto us a comfort of knowing that his presence in our life, and his care for our life, are constant. This means that God sees the actions that everyone else sees, and also the ones that no one sees. He knows the thoughts that filter through our minds, and he also knows the ones that we dwell upon. God is ultimately acquainted with all of mankind, and he pays attention to every detail of every person whom he has created. There is nothing that we can do that surprises God, for God already knows all things. Now, it is important to remember that it is not because God has knowledge of all that we will do that we do not have to be responsible for our choices in life, because our choices are real, and we must be held responsible for our choices, for we must actively choose whether we are going to obey or disobey the truth of Gods word. Therefore, we can be reassured that the choices that we make are entirely our own, but God knows all, and has chosen to love us unconditionally.

Psalm 139: 5 - 6,....thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid their hand upon me....such knowledge is too wonderful for me....I cannot attain unto it....

As believers, God not only has complete and intimate knowledge of us, but he is to be involved in every aspect of our life. God surrounds us, so that he might give unto us continment, and protection, and he reveals unto us the nature of his knowledge. This will help us to remove the worldly emotion of fear from our life, so that we might began to comprehend the breadth, and length, and depth, and height of the love of God.

Ephesians 3: 17 - 19,....that Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith....being rooted and grounded in love....may be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height....and to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with the fulness of God....

God would have that we as believers would be spiritually strengthened in our life in Christ. For it is this spiritual maturity that enables us to understand and acknowledge the immeasurable dimensions of his love. Therefore, we pray for one another to experience in our relationship with him a love that will transform the lives of all who will believe, so that we might be enabled to live out our lives here on earth in the fulness of the glory of God.

Psalm 139: 7-12,... whither shall I go from thy spirit, or whither shall I flee from thy presence...if I ascend....into heaven, thou art there...if I make my bed in hell....thou there....if I take....wings....and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea....there shall thy hand lead me....and hold me....if I say, surely the darkness shall cover me, even the night shall be light about me....the darkness hideth not from thee, but the night shineth as the day, the darkness and the light are both alike to thee....

As believers, we must learn to understand the inescapable nature of God's presence. So, when I feel that I am at my best in my relationship with Christ, should this be the only time that I have the ability to acknowledge the presence of God. What about those times that I have chosen the wrong direction for my life, am I still in the presence of an almighty God.

Jonah 2: 1-7,....Jonah prayed....and said, I cried by reason of mine affliction....out of the belly of hell cried I, and thou hearest my voice....when my soul fainted within me, I remembered the Lord, and my prayer came in unto thee....

Gods' presence, and his guidance extends to every part of the universe, offering comfort and security to all who will trust in him. This means that God is active in our life through every situation, circumstance, trial, tribulation, temptation, whatever we might be experiencing Gods strength will hold us fast, preventing our continual fall, and his hand will lead us safely back into his righteousness.

Psalm 139: 13 - 16,....thou hast possessed my reigns, thou hast covered me in my mothers womb....I will praise thee....marvelous are thy works....thine eyes did see my substance....in thy book all....were written....
